Target Passage → Psalm 1

- 1) What three things does the blessed person *not* do? Explain.
- 2) What does delighting in God's law (Scripture) look like? What is the result?
- 3) What is the result of walking, standing, and sitting in wickedness?

Bridge Passages (for further study) → Proverbs 4:10-27, Jeremiah 17:5-10

For Me →

- 1) Would you say you delight in the Word of God? What has been the result of this for you?
- 2) Paul Tripp wrote, *"The gospel of Jesus Christ is meant to be your life hermeneutic, that is, the means by which you understand and make sense of life. This is important because human beings don't live life based on the facts of their experience but on the interpretation of the facts. Whether they are aware of it or not, every human being is a meaning maker, a theologian, a philosopher, or an anthropologist, always taking things apart to understand what they mean."* In light of this, why is the right source of wisdom so important?
- 3) What common worldly wisdom (foolishness) is popular today? How does God's wisdom correct this?

For the Mission →

Do you have a friend who is walking, standing, or sitting in wickedness? What can you do to help your friend see the error of that way?

PRAYER FOCUS

Ask the Lord to give you the discernment to recognize foolishness and the opportunity to speak Godly wisdom into the lives of your friends who are walking, standing, or sitting in it.
