Target Passage → Philippians 1:3-6

Bridge Passages (for further study) → Acts 16:11-15, I John 1:1-5

For Me →

- 1) What are some gospel partnerships that have been especially meaningful to you during the years you’ve been a Christian? Why were these partnerships significant? What did they accomplish?
- 2) Do you consider yourself a partner of Calvary EFC? Why or why not?

For the Mission →

- 1) What can solid gospel partnerships help us accomplish as a church *locally*?
- 2) What about *globally*?
