Target Passage → John 1:9-13

- 1. In his message, John described darkness and true light in this text. Define what darkness true light are in this passage.
- 2. John said not all light is the *true* light. There are fakes. Discuss what our world throws at us as light which is not true light that gives life.
- 3. Tim used the story of his friend donating a kidney to a stranger simple because there was a need, and she was a close match. He said this illustrated well what the Savior was sent to do to be a donor. Discuss as a group our need.
- 4. What are reasons so many in our world do need (darkness/death) or want what Jesus came to give (light and life)?
- 5. Tim said the primary culprit is our teaching from the cradle up we have been taught "dialysis" that we can remove any darkness/toxins from our lives through our own efforts. Do you agree or disagree. Explain
- 6. According to this passage, there are two ways people respond to the Savior's offer of "light of life" receive not and receive. Define from the message what **receive** means.
- 7. Tim stated that John uses the word "believe" 98 times in his Gospel always as a verb or participles (action), never as a noun (a thing). Discuss the difference between seeing our response to the Savior as an ACTION, not a THING.
- 8. Look up the word "believe" and "believed" in John's Gospel in a concordance (example, Biblegateway on your phone). Read examples of people in his Gospel who believed or did not believe. Was their response an action or a thing?
