- 3. What did the people conclude about Jesus based on what they saw? Why?
- 4. Jesus' miracles are pictures of spiritual truths about the kingdom of God. What does this picture teach us?

- 1. What's the difference between Christian and non-Christian sorrow? How does a Christian suffer differently?
- 2. How does the resurrecting power of Jesus speak to one of our greatest longings as human beings?
