- 4. What do we learn about the identity of Jesus from this incident?
- 5. What should faith in Jesus look like?

Bridge Passages (for further study) → Psalm 104, Mark 4:35-41, Philippians 4:4-7

For Me →

- 1. Describe a time when a trial or pressure exposed your faith in Christ in a way that caused you to realize it wasn't as strong as you thought it was.
- 2. How does the sovereignty of Christ over the whole created order strengthen your faith in times of difficulty?

For the Mission →

1. How can this passage help us bring hope to someone who is going through a difficult time?
