Target Passage → 1 Samuel 2:12-26

- 1. Explain what Eli's sons were doing wrong and why that behavior is such an affront to the Lord. How does their position make this sin especially egregious?
- 2. How are Samuel and his family contrasted with Eli's family? What does this teach us about true, good spiritual leadership?
- 3. Why wouldn't Eli's sons listen to their father and change their behavior? Explain the theology.
- 4. How does this passage serve as both a warning to spiritual leaders and guidance for how to find good spiritual leadership?
