- 2. Why do the people want a king and what does this mean for their relationship with the Lord?
- 3. What will an earthly, worldly king do? Why will he do this? How is this a description of the results of all sin?
- 4. If nothing good will come from appointing a king like the nations, why do the elders of Israel insist on having one?

- 1. What does it look like for someone to reject the Lord from being king over him/her? Can someone remain a Christian and still do this? Explain.
- 2. Describe a time you blew past the stop signs of God's Word and later felt the consequences of your sin. What did you learn about the Lord from that experience?
