Target Passage: 1 Samuel 9:1-25

- 1. It seems that Saul had not heard of or seen Samuel previously. How can this be? What does this say about Saul's spiritual health?
- 2. Why does Saul insist on bringing something to present to the man of God?
- 3. Our God is a God who saves, sees, and hears. How should these truths change our behavior?
- 4. Why do you think that Samuel invited Saul to the sacrifice and a meal? Why wait to anoint him king?
- 5. Recall some recent examples of how God has provided for you. How have you experienced the Lord as your portion?

Bridge Passages (for further study): Psalm 18; Matthew 6:25-34; Ephesians 1:3-14 For Me:

- 1. From what do you derive your identity? Is your identity found in Christ alone, or do you place your trust in others or other things?
- 2. How does the knowledge of God's sovereignty impact your response to events, trials, and tribulations?
