Target Passages → Luke 16:1-13

1. Work through the parable a little bit at a time and ensure that everyone in the group follows the details of the story.
2. What does Jesus mean when he tells us to make friends by means of unrighteous wealth?
3. How is our use of wealth an indication of our hearts?
4. How can money become a master? How would we know if it has become our master?

Bridge Passages (for further study) → Luke 12:35-48, Colossians 3:1-4

For Me →

1. Do you find yourself ever thinking about wealth in a worldly way? How? What do you do to avoid this error?
2. Would you say you use your wealth strategically the way Jesus describes here?

For the Mission →

1. How can we practically use our wealth to make friends and invest in eternity?
2. How should a church think about its resources (those given by the people of the church)? How does a church use its resources in accordance with Jesus' teaching in this passage?
