Target Passage → Luke 19:1-10

1. Luke tells us Zacchaeus was a tax collector and rich. What does this tell us about Zacchaeus' social status in 1st century Israel?
2. How does Jesus know Zacchaeus' name? What does this tell us about this encounter and how it fulfills Jesus' mission (vs.10)?
3. What is going on in Zacchaeus' heart concerning wealth? Describe the two vows he makes and what they mean for his faith.
4. Why does Jesus say salvation has come to Zacchaeus' house after he makes these vows? Is Zacchaeus saved because of his financial sacrifice? Explain.

Bridge Passages (for further study) → Ezekiel 34:11-16, John 10:22-30, Romans 3:10-12

For Me →

1. When Jesus the Shepherd came and found you, what were you doing?
2. What is going on in your heart concerning wealth? Is it an idol? Is it a way for you to worship? Explain.

For the Mission →

Are there people in your life who would see Jesus' more clearly in you if you went to them and made up for what you've done fourfold? Explain.
