Praying together

Pastoral Search Team — We ask you to be in continual prayer for Calvary’s Lead Pastor search. Using Hebrews 13:21 – “Equip the Pastoral Search Team with everything good for doing your will, working in them that which is pleasing to you, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.”

As Calvary searches for its next Lead Pastor, pray that God would raise up one who preaches the Word of God, patiently correcting, rebuking, and encouraging our congregation with good teaching. (II Timothy 4:2)
