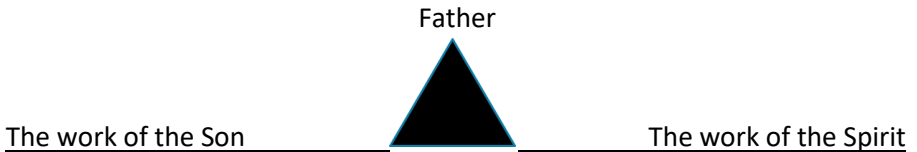
This is a trustworthy saying, and I want you to insist on these teachings so that all who trust in God will devote themselves to doing good. These teachings are good and beneficial for everyone.

Lead Pastor Search — We ask you to be in continual prayer for Calvary's Lead Pastor search. (This prayer is written by a Calvary member who is committed to praying for our present pastoral search and wants to encourage us to undergird our pastoral search in prayer.)

Pray that we would not be deceived in this current time where there is so much spiritual deception (I Timothy 4:1). Pray that we may not be a church that accumulates teachers who tickle our ears (II Timothy 4:3-4).
